Introduction

A Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) was first introduced into the United Kingdom in 1948 for use in classifying business establishments and other statistical units by the type of economic activity in which they are engaged. Businesses are classified by their main type of economic activity - the classification is based on the types of products made or the service given and covers everything from 'Abattoir' to 'Zoological Gardens'. It is revised from time to time as new products and the new industries that produce them emerge and emphasis shifts in existing industries.

The United Kingdom Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities is used to classify business establishments and other standard units by the type of economic activity in which they are engaged. It provides a framework for the collection, tabulation, presentation and analysis of data and its use promotes uniformity. In addition, it can be used for administrative purposes and by non-government bodies as a convenient way of classifying industrial activities into a common structure.

The system is identical to the EUROSTAT System NACE at the four digit class level and the United Nations system ISIC at the two digit Divisional level.

The Office for National Statistics has published a major revision of the UK Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities (SIC). The revision commenced in 2002 and was completed in 2007. It is effective from 1 January 2008 and is the outcome of a series of consultations carried out in conjunction with a major revision of the European Union's industrial classification system, NACE (NACE Rev. 2).

The UK is required by European legislation to revise the SIC in parallel with NACE so that both systems remain identical down to and including the 4 digit class level. A further breakdown is provided for certain classes by the addition of a 5 digit subclass level.

Both the UK SIC (2007) and NACE Rev. 2 are completely consistent with the fourth revision of the UN's International Standard Industrial Classification of all Economic Activities (ISIC rev. 4). The revisions are motivated by the need to adapt the classifications to changes in the world economy. The revised classifications reflect the growing importance of service activities in the economy over the last fifteen years, mainly due to the developments in information and communication technologies (ICT).

Who uses SIC Codes?

The classification provides a framework for the collection, tabulation, presentation and analysis of data and its use promotes uniformity. In addition, it can be used for administrative purposes and by non-government bodies as a convenient way of classifying industrial activities into a common structure.

SIC codes enable statistics to be compiled by Government agencies - for example:

- Companies House classify companies by SIC;
- HM Customs and Excise require registrants to specify the SIC applicable to their business.

SIC codes are a great benefit to people wishing to target potential customers with a direct marketing campaign. SIC codes are invaluable in marketing. You can identify your prospective customers and target them by a variety of selections – such as by type of business using UK SIC codes, geographically, by corporate data, or financial performance.



The UK SIC Codes

The following table shows the main changes, at section level, between SIC 2003 and SIC 2007. SIC 2003 has 17 sections and 62 divisions. SIC 2007 has 21 sections and 88 divisions.

Companies House and SIC 2007

The United Kingdom Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities (SIC) is used to classify business establishments and other standard units by the type of economic activity in which they are engaged. The new version of these codes (SIC 2007) has been adopted by the UK from 1 January 2008. The following Q&As explains why Companies House has not yet moved to the new version of the codes:

What is SIC 2007?

It's the latest version of the SICs which was previously revised in 2003. It's a numerical classification that Companies House adopted to identify company principal business activities which are required to be stated on the annual return (form 363) each year.

When did it come into force?

The new classification system was adopted by the UK on 1 January 2008.

What is Companies House doing to adopt the new version?

Due to the implementation of a new internal IT system the new SIC codes will not be adopted immediately by Companies House.

When will Companies House adopt SIC 2007?

Once their new IT system is up and running and have been fully tested, Companies House will look to implement the new version of the codes. They will let customers know in plenty of time prior to the change being made.

What will happen if I use an SIC 2007 code instead of an SIC 2003 code after 1 January 2008?

Companies House will convert any SIC 2007 code used to SIC 2003 on their records. But you should ensure that you continue to use the current version (SIC 2003) of the codes. This version will not change on Companies House guidance, on the pre printed return or their electronic filing systems.

Why can't Companies House just accept SIC 2007 codes from 1 January 2008?

The classification system is prescribed by statutory instrument and the current prescribed scheme is SIC 2003. Companies

House cannot accept SIC 2007 codes until the scheme is changed to that version by an amended statutory instrument. They will not be in a position to change the scheme until they know for certain when they will be able to implement their new IT system.

Is there anything different my company has to do after 1 January 2008?

No, just carry on using your current SIC 2003 code when filing an annual return until, Companies House are ready to accept the new codes.
